- 9. Each bout shall consist of three rounds to two minutes each, with one minute's interval be twine the rounds.
- 10. Ordinarily no competitor shall be called upon to box more than one bout in a day.
- 11. In all matters pertaining to bouts the decision of the referee shall be final.
- 12. The competition will be conducted in 10 weight categories each for Men & Women Section.
- 13. Every college sending its team to participate in an Inter Collegiate Tournament shall appoint a whole time employed, responsible male or female staff member along with the team to look after its welfare.

Winner's Speech:


